It is the policy of the Trails West council that all Scouts desiring to leave camp during a Boy Scout Summer Camping session, prior to the troop's departure, must be accompanied by their parents or guardian, and have completed the following release.

In an emergency, it may not be possible for a parent or guardian to complete this form. In this event, a Scoutmaster of the Scout unit will complete this form. Sufficient information attesting to any telephone call or means of communication with the parents or guardian requesting release of the Scout must be documented.

Campers may be released to:

1. Registered adult member of their own unit.
2. Registered adult staff of Trails West Council
3. Persons listed on the campers Trails West Council " Scout Release Request."
4. Adults not authorized on camper's Trails West Council "Scout Release Request" upon verbal confirmation and/or written authorization of authorized persons as specified on camp records.
5. Picture identification may be required.
